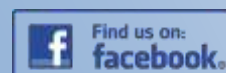

DENVER SEMINARY PREPARATION

DESCRIPTION: Spring International Language Center's Seminary Preparation program is designed to equip students with the necessary English and cultural skills as well as a base of theological knowledge for seminary studies. After completing the seminary preparation program at SILC, students will have the skills needed to enter and succeed at the seminary level without a TOEFL score.

CLASSES: **Twenty-three** hours of classes each week in all skills: **Grammar, Writing, Reading, Listening/Speaking, and Seminary Preparation** which includes Theological Vocabulary, Seminary level Writing skills, and Seminary level presentation skills.

LEVELS: Seminary preparation students are placed in one of Spring International Language Center's six levels of intensive English. Seminary preparation courses begin as early as Level 4.

TERMS: The seminary preparation program follows the intensive English program calendar; however, half terms are limited because two terms are required for recommendation to Denver Seminary.

SCHEDULE: 9:00 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. with a one hour break for lunch (5 hours of classes per day). No classes Friday afternoon, which equals twenty-three (23) instructional hours per week.

TESTING & PLACEMENT Students are given The Michigan English Placement Test, a written composition, and an oral interview on the first day of the term to determine placement in levels. The Michigan Test of English Language Proficiency is given at the end of the term to measure progress.

HOUSING **Homestays** with American families. Assistance provided for students who want to stay in apartments.

FEES per TERM **Tuition** \$3200 per nine-week term, **student services fee** \$200, **homestay fee** \$1,680 per term (includes breakfast and dinner), books approximately \$200, **health insurance** \$250 (**9 weeks**), **application fee** (one-time, non-refundable) \$125.

Fees for each half term: (5 weeks): Tuition \$1800, **student services fee** \$200, Homestay Fee \$940, Books \$200 (estimate), **health insurance** \$250 (**9 weeks**), **application fee** (one-time, non-refundable) \$125.
