Minimum Age:

Participants must be 16 years or older.

Tuition and Homestay Fee:

The Tuition and Homestay Fee includes room and board, books, class materials, and all planned activities.

Application Fee: \$125
3-Week Program: \$2,700

Classes and Field Trips:

The program includes 32 instructional hours that emphasize conversational English and field trips to educational and cultural points of interest.

Staff:

Classes are taught by professionals with degrees and experience in Teaching English as a Second Language.

Accommodations:

Participants will be placed with an American host family during their stay. Breakfast and dinner are provided. Students buy lunch at the college cafeteria or a local restaurant.

Airport Pick-up and Drop-off:
